You know, summer is supposed to be a slow time in the church, but in the five years I've been at Wyandotte UMC, I've not found that to be the case here. We don't stop having Sunday school because it's summer. We continue to have a number of groups meeting on their regular schedule, and we don't stop having worship! And then in addition to these regular ongoing activities we pick up a few more. As I write this, we are preparing to enjoy excellent fellowship at our 5th Sunday potluck on June 30.

Plans for Vacation Bible School are beginning. This year we are considering a one-day VBS just before school starts. In the past we have worked with Trinity for VBS, but with their recent closing, we are hopeful that some of those wonderful people we have worked with before will join us still. We can always use more volunteers, and of course, CHILDREN! As always, there is no cost to the children participating. Please watch for the posters that will give you an opportunity to volunteer, to sponsor a child for VBS, or to provide supplies even if you can't physically participate.

Many other things going on also fill our plates and cause our cups to overflow. We continue to host the Chin Christian Mission congregation for the use of our sanctuary and a couple of classrooms on Sunday afternoons from 1-4 PM. They have also begun using Sunday School space on Wednesday and Saturday afternoons to teach their English-speaking children the Chin language. We can use some additional volunteers to be present as hosts on Sunday afternoons, just in case an emergency would arise. If you could help out in this way once a month or so, please speak with Colleen Cook or leave a message with the office.

Also, as of July 1, we have Scouts again! My son started Cub Scouts at Wyandotte years ago, so it makes me exceedingly happy that we will once again be sponsoring both Cub Scout Pack 3005, and Boy Scout Troop 5. They will meet downstairs on Monday nights beginning at 7 PM. Please make them feel welcome. If you would like to volunteer to help in some way with the Scouts, please let Steve Dominic know.

I also want to take this opportunity to welcome our new members who have come to us through transfer from Trinity Community Church. I recognize that this is a time of grief for many of you, but I hope that you will give us a chance to care for you and that you will find a new home here. I'm hoping you will join us for worship, but I understand that you may need some time to heal. I was member of Trinity from 1994-2006, until I was appointed to my first ministry assignment, so I already know many of you, and look forward to meeting those I don't yet know. Don't be surprised if you receive a call from me asking if I can visit you in your home or meet you somewhere for coffee, tea, or a meal.

Finally, don't forget to pick up school supplies for our local elementary school, Claude Huyck. We have narrowed the list to those things that they need the most, and you can find a copy on the back of the calendar included in this newsletter. Please bring the supplies to the church by July 28.

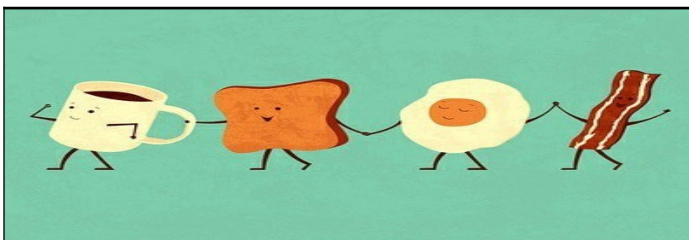

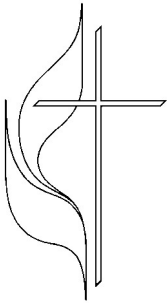
