I hope everyone continues to be well and is learning to adjust to what our world has become. We stopped meeting in person beginning March 15, and have been worshipping online since March 22. This has been a big change for so many of us, but we continue to adapt to a continually changing environment. We all miss being together and seeing one another, but we must do what we must do to care for and protect one another.

The Administrative Council met on June 14 to consider when we might reopen for inperson worship, and what would be required when we did. The concerns included the physical distancing that would be required, extra sanitization procedures, the need to wear masks, and the inability to share refreshments or really even have a fellowship time before or after worship. These are concerns both from a health, and a liability standpoint. We spent much of the time discussing the safety of singing. After an hour and a half of discussion, the Board unanimously concluded that we should continue to worship online as we have been doing, at least through the month of July. The general consensus was, "If we can't sing, and we can't have fellowship, are we really able to worship?"

So, for the time being, we will continue to worship with pre-recorded services on our website at www.wyandotteumc.com or on Facebook at www.facebook.com/ Wyandotteumc. Postings on both sites go live at 7:00 AM Sunday mornings. You may make comments on the Facebook page. If you watch it on the website, you may email your comments to me at pastor@wyandotteumc.com .

That said, I will once again offer drive-thru communion in the west parking lot on Sunday, July 5, this time from 11:00 AM - noon. We had a very good turnout in June for this, and I expect even more may choose to take advantage of this opportunity. I will have a station set up on the south end of the west parking area, where I will provide consecrated elements in sealed containers to the occupants of the cars. We can then say a prayer together, and you can be on your way. I ask that you enter from the west and leave to the east to avoid traffic congestion. If you haven't picked up a new directory yet, you can pick one up then, as well as Upper Room devotionals. Administrative Council will meet again at noon on Sunday, July 19, to revisit the question of reopening the building. Please continue to pray for our leadership as we make difficult decisions.

I'll remind you again of the three simple rules: Do no harm. Do good. Stay in love with God. We're all striving to do the best we can under the circumstances, and I thank you again for your patience during these challenging times. I look forward to when we can safely gather together again.


Is planning to resume again Friday, September 4, 2020 at the Parsonage, from 6:30-8:30 PM.
