"Becoming passionately outward-focused for Jesus Christ." Springtime greetings, one and all! As we begin, I want to draw your attention to two important dates this month. April 1 is Maundy Thursday, and we will have a service at 6:00 PM at which we will observe the Lord's Supper and hear the story of Jesus' last hours. Sunday, April 4 is Easter, when we will once again have Holy Communion.

We returned to the Sanctuary for the 11:00 service on March 21, and because of the high turnout and limited seating, we have decided that for **Easter Sunday only, April 4**, we will have **two services**, one at **8:30 AM** and one at **11:00 AM**. After that, we will return again to having only the one service at 11:00 with overflow seating in Fellowship Hall.

The limited seating in our sanctuary is a temporary situation until such time as it is safe to resume pre-COVID practices. If you attended worship on March 21, you would have noticed that there are a lot of things that are different. Some of the safety measures we have in place may be off-putting to some, but to others, they offer an added sense of safety and security. As I've said before, much of our United Methodist doctrine can be summed up in the three simple rules: "Do no harm; Do good; Stay in love with God." We're all striving to do the best we can under the circumstances, and I thank you again for your patience during these challenging times.

With spring beginning to blossom all around us, we will resume our walking group on April 6. On Tuesdays and Thursdays we will limit the walk to one mile on relatively flat ground, but on Wednesdays and Fridays, we will step it up a notch in pace, distance, and/or terrain. At least to start out, we will meet at 7:30 AM each day at the stop sign at 79th & Oakland. At some point in the future, the Wednesday/Friday walks may be moved to other locations. If you have questions, feel free to give me a call.

As we move into Eastertide, the lectionary Old Testament readings are replaced by lessons from the Acts of the Apostles (book of Acts). I will be presenting a new sermon series called "Actions Speak Louder" based on these readings. As the new disciples put feet to the ground in the ministry of this new thing called Christianity, they faced a number of obstacles and challenges, and learned much about themselves along the way. What can we as the church today learn about ourselves and our ministry from the adventure stories of those early Christians? How can we be the church in an ever changing world? I hope you will join us throughout the season of Easter as we learn together.

Have a blessed Easter season, and I hope to see you soon!




