Welcome back! As most of you know, we returned to regular in-person worship on March 21, and two services for Easter and during the month of May. We thought that as we returned to a more normal schedule of two services, some of those who had not yet returned would begin coming back. However, our attendance has been running consistently around 35 whether we have one or two services. With that being the case, the Administrative Board voted in May to move to one service effective June 6. We will be worshipping at 10:00 AM on Sunday mornings. We're hopeful that as more people return to worship, we can once again revisit the idea of two services.

NEW WORSHIP TIME BEGINNING JUNE 6 10:00 AM

As we move into the summer months, I am beginning a new series called "God Sightings – More Than Meets the Eye." While this series will follow the lectionary, I will be focusing on where we see God at work in the world. How can the events of our everyday lives inform our faith and how can our faith inform our everyday lives. I will be drawing on the insights offered by the books *Looking for God in Messy Places* by Episcopal Bishop Jake Owensby, and *God Sightings: the Creator Is Everywhere*, a book of devotionals written by Macy John. As Christian believers, it is necessary for us to examine our surroundings carefully in order to perceive how God is showing up in them. Power, faith, transformation, and salvation often appear in ways we do not expect. God's work is radical, unusual, and often surprising, working behind the scenes and beneath the surface. This series, drawing primarily on Paul's second letter to the church at Corinth, focuses on the various ways that members of the Christian community are called to look closely and deeply at where, when, and how God works beyond our expectations.

I hope you will be able to join with us as we move into the months of summer. Check out the calendar on page 3 for all the things that are going on at the church. We have begun to relax masking and distancing requirements, and it's beginning to feel more like church as we've known it in the past. For now, we will continue to follow the guidelines established by the Unified Government, but are moving toward masks being optional for those who have been fully vaccinated. We still request that unvaccinated individuals wear masks for the protection of themselves and others. Have a great month, and I hope to see you in church!

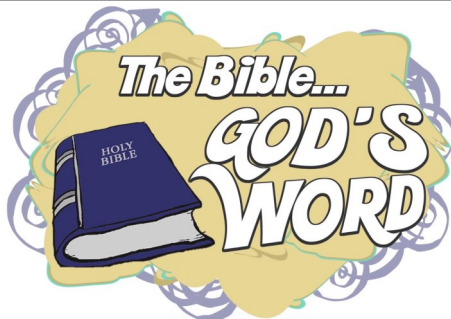

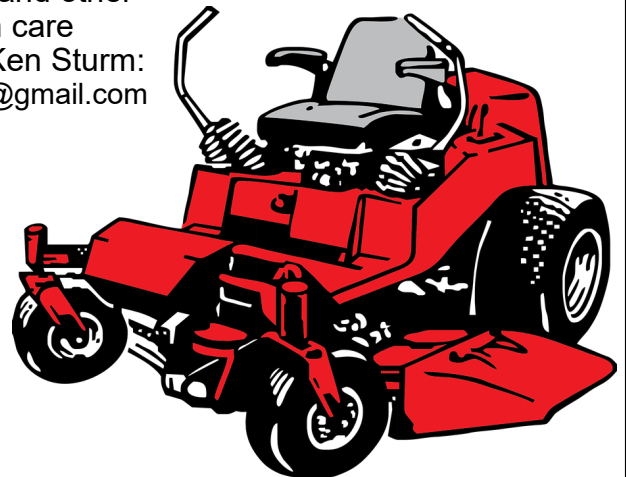

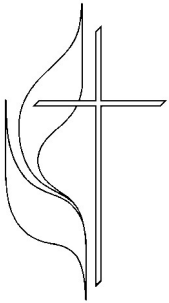
