My dear friends,

By the time you read this, I'll be gone. No, not in any permanent sort of way (I hope), but after church on Sunday, August 29, Steve and I will be leaving for a week of vacation, with three days of continuing education smack dab in the middle. We will be traveling to Colorado Springs to see our son, who is scheduled to deploy to parts unknown on Labor Day, and I will spend Tuesday through Thursday at the Center for Pastoral Effectiveness. Labor Day weekend there is a hot-air balloon event in Colorado Springs, and we have tickets for Saturday. We will begin our trip back on Sunday, September 5. Since I will not be here on the first Sunday, Communion this month will be moved to September 12. **If you need pastoral care in my absence, please contact Rev. For the month of September we will move into a series on the Epistle of James called Doers of the Word. This book gives us a chance to reflect on the nature of Christian service and how we can continue our mission of making disciples of Jesus Christ for the transformation of the world by engaging with our wider community in acts of service. One thing that is clear from current sociological research is that while there are many who question the institution of the church, getting involved in providing real help to better our neighborhoods and to lift up the individuals and families within them is an easy entry into the worship life of the church. James asks us to maintain an outward focus, even when we gather for worship. We invite you to engage with this epistle as we seek to be doers of the word.

Things around the church are beginning to liven up. We're having a few more activities happening, and there are increasing opportunities for fellowship. I want to remind everyone that we continue to be under a mask mandate from the Unified Government. The mandate specifically calls out places of worship, and that means our church. The mandate also provides for stiff penalties for organizations (not individuals) which fail to comply. Please continue mask up anytime you are participating in an activity in the church.

We are still evaluating the results of the survey we collected during August, but one of the things mentioned was Trunk 'N' Treat. The Education Committee is once again planning this event to be held Saturday, October 23, on the back lawn. Please begin collecting wrapped candy that can be used as prizes, and plan your games as we resume this time of fun for the children of our church and neighborhood.

Thank you to all the volunteers who so faithfully perform the duties you have been asked to do. Your contributions do not go unnoticed although we sometimes may seem to take them for granted. If anyone would like to volunteer in any way, please let the office know, and we can connect you with the right people to make it happen.

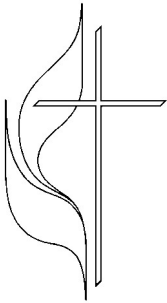
