"Becoming passionately outward-focused for Jesus Christ." Winter greetings to you all!

I tell you, February is often a difficult month for me; sometimes the cold, gloomy days just get me down. We've had a good winter so far, other than a few brutally cold days. for the most part, I believe it has been warmer than usual. But sometimes, conditions are such that it may be unsafe for people to come to in-person worship. Twice already this year, we have had snow and/or ice storms on Saturday, that have resulted in our church making the difficult decision to cancel in-person Sunday worship. Sometimes, even when our crews have been able to get the sidewalks clear, the streets around the church remain hazardous, and we do not want to put our members at risk. When this happens, and the Trustees, the Administrative Board Chair, and I, together, make the decision to close, there are a number of ways we try to keep everyone informed. The information will be posted on our Facebook page, a One-Call and email will be sent out, and the information will be provided to television stations KCTV (5), KMBC (9). KSHB (41), and their affiliates (62, 29, 38) for posting. We have been unable, to date, to be provided access to the WDAF Fox 4 closing system, despite repeated attempts. If you have not been receiving our One-Calls with reminders of upcoming events and would like to be included in this system, please let us know by calling the office and giving us the phone number you would like us to use, and we will add you.

We continue to gather on the first and third Wednesdays of the month for our Wyandotte Dinners Out. This was originally envisioned as an outreach to give us more visibility in the community and to offer an opportunity to invite friends to join us, away from the church building, for a time of fellowship and conversation. Sometimes people outside of the church can be frightened or "put off" by "church people," and this is a fairly informal way to just be regular people in community. Since we began in October, we have had a regular attendance at these dinners of 15-20 people, and it's been a lot of fun. Recently, however, it became apparent that for some, it is becoming a trusted, safe place, where they can share their struggles, and seek true companionship and accountability in the sometimes difficult aspects of navigating life. Whatever it is to you, I hope you will consider joining us for one (or more) of these evenings. More information about these gatherings can be found on the calendar and elsewhere in this newsletter.

Our continuing sermon series is built on seeing the light of Christ through the lens of love. "Love Never Ends" is both a description and a promise. You are invited to continue to journey with us, guided by the Corinthian epistles to let the light shine around you, and in you, and from you as we seek to be disciples of Jesus Christ for the transformation of the world. We who have seen the light of Christ now desire to reflect it in our community and in our world by letting others see Christ through our loving presence.

My sister-in-law gave me a desktop calendar for 2022 that offers sayings that can be placed on a church sign. Sometimes they are puns, but sometimes they are poignant. Today, as I write this, it offers this insight: "Sometimes God says yes, Sometimes God says no, and sometimes God says wait..." As we continue to face the challenges of living in a pandemic, as we wake up to another gloomy winter morning, as we seek to determine "what's next?", we have this promise of God, offered through Jesus Christ, and sustained by the Holy Spirit: "Peace I leave with you; my peace I give to you. I do not give to you as the world gives. Do not let your hearts be troubled, and do not let them be afraid." (John 14:7)

As the days lengthen and dawn breaks earlier each morning, may we look to Christ's light to brighten the gloom in our hearts and minds and may we reflect that light into our community. May we seek Christ's peace in all our troubles, and may we not be afraid.




The Crusaders Class is an adult Sunday school class that meets in the room just off Fellowship Hall. They participate in a number of different studies. This class also meets at 9:00 am.


