Well, we're into the home stretch! Easter will be here before you know it, and with it, all the related activities.

Our Lenten Bible study continues through April 13. Each Wednesday throughout Lent we have been gathering on Wednesday nights in Fellowship Hall for a meal and a study of Jesus' last week on earth as we read it in in the gospel according to Mark. Our study is based on the book by Marcus Borg and John Dominic Crossan called *The Last Week: What the Gospels Really Teach About Jesus's Final Days in Jerusalem.* I have read this book at least five times, and each time I read it, I learn something new. The twenty or so participants in the study continue to be challenged by the gospels as we approach them through a slightly different lens than many studies. And we've had some really good food, too! You can still join us for the remaining two session on April 6 and 13. We gather at 6 for the meal and begin the study about 6:30.

On Saturday, April 9, we will have our Easter egg hunt at the church. We will gather in the morning at 10:00 to fill the eggs, and then the hunt will take place in the afternoon with registration beginning at 2:30 with a craft and a story, and then the children will be released about 3:00 PM to the designated areas to grab all the eggs they can. Please bring wrapped small candy items to the church by noon Friday, April 8 so we know if we need to purchase more before Saturday. WE DO NOT NEED EGGS! We will need assistance filling and hiding the eggs, and general oversight during the hunt itself. I hope you can join us!

We will have a Maundy Thursday service at 7:00 PM on Thursday, April 14. This is a communion service at which we recall the Last Supper that Jesus observed with his disciples.

On Easter Sunday, we will have an early service beginning at 7:30. It's not quite sunrise, but it is an observance of SON-rise. This will be followed by breakfast in Fellowship Hall beginning about 8:30 and continuing until 9:30. Sunday school will take place as usual at 9, and we will celebrate the resurrection of our Savior with communion at our regular service at 10:00 AM. I think we have cooking the breakfast covered, but could probably use a couple of breakfast casseroles to supplement. Let me know if you can provide one.

The Sunday after Easter, April 24, heralds the return of Holy Humor Sunday. I haven't done this in few years, and the time seems right. This is one you get to help with! Begin sending me your favorite (clean) jokes and memes for possible inclusion, and if you've been waiting for a chance to try out your own stand-up routine, let me know, and I'm almost certain we can provide that opportunity.

After that, I'll be heading out of town (hopefully, not on a rail)! I will be attending continuing education in Colorado Springs the week of April 25-29. If you have a pastoral care need during my absence, you may contact Rev. Gary Roellchen at 913-602-0660.

Finally, now that spring has fully sprung (I hope), we will once again begin our neighborhood walks on Tuesdays and Thursdays at 8:00 AM. We'll meet in front of the church and take a little stroll around the neighborhood. The intensity of the walk depends on who wants to participate. Let me know if you'd like to join us.

As you can see, April is going to be another busy month. Let's continue to seek ways of bringing new people to Jesus through our love of our neighbors. Feel free to invite others to any and all of our regular activities, and keep looking for places where we can reach new people with the love of Christ.


