Following breakfast and Sunday school, we worshiped again at 10:00 AM. Combined attendance at both services approached pre-pandemic levels. Earlier in the week, our Maundy Thursday service was also well-attended as we welcomed visiting friends from Victory Hills Baptist Church. Please continue to invite your friends to join us in any of our activities.

The season after Easter is where we consider what it means to walk with Jesus into eternity. But it is not about life after death, or rather not only about life after death. It is very much about life before death, life in the face of death. It is about life and about bearing witness to a life that resembles a kin-dom existence right here and right now. It is this life, this justice and righteousness, this hope and this glory to which we can say with confidence, "We are witnesses." The Acts of the Apostles will be our guide along this journey.

Thank you all for your contributions to the church to support Mobility Worldwide. We had set a goal of providing 10 mobility carts at a cost \$350 each. As of Easter Sunday, (and the writing of this article) we had raised enough for 25 carts! There is still a chance that more will come in, so stay tuned for Ruth Miller's Moment for Mission the second Sunday in May for the final tally! There will be a celebratory event in Columbia, Missouri in mid-July. Wouldn't it be fun to take a group there to celebrate? Let me know if you would be interested in attending.

Finally, during the last several months, our church has been participating in research on projects through Churches United for Justice to address issues of housing and violence in Wyandotte County. I'm grateful for Ken Sturm and Colleen Cook who have done the heavy lifting of attending innumerable Zoom meetings as this research has been conducted. The Churches United for Justice will have a rally on May 3 to introduce and prepare to seek justice for housing and violence in Wyandotte County. I'm asking that we provide a united front from Wyandotte Church in support of this important work. It would be great if we could have at least 30 people there. The Rally will take place beginning at 6:00 PM on May 3, 2022 at Oak Ridge Missionary Baptist Church, 9301 Parallel.

As we move into the spring and summer, we need to continue to seek opportunities to connect with our community and beyond to not only grow our church, but also the Kingdom of God. Let's all do our part!

SUNDAY SCHOOL Two Adult Sunday School Classes are available






