As we move into the summer months, I am beginning a new series called "Living the Spirit Life." June 5 is Pentecost. Pentecost is also the beginning of the long season we sometimes call Ordinary Time. The word ordinary comes from ordinal, meaning we count the Sundays—first Sunday after Pentecost, second Sunday after Pentecost, and so on. We don't mean ordinary as in run of the mill and boring, same old, same old. No, in Ordinary Time, we are called; we are invited; we are equipped and empowered to live the Spirit life—a life first lived by the one we call Lord, Jesus of Nazareth. We take the reins, and we live for him, even as he lives in us. It's Pentecost again, time to celebrate and give thanks. And to live the Spirit life.

June 7 marks an amazing opportunity for our community as we celebrate our first-ever Nehemiah Assembly with the Churches United for Justice in Wyandotte County! Many people from several Wyandotte County churches have been working together behind the scenes for several months to look at the issues of homelessness and violence in our neighborhoods. This assembly represents the culmination of their efforts as we bring the concerns and ideas for solutions to the attention of community leaders and government officials in this public forum. Our goal is to have over 1000 people gathered for this community event. I hope everyone can join us at Mt. Carmel Church of God in Christ at 13<sup>th</sup> and Parallel on June 7, 6:00 PM – 7:30 PM. It is a free event, but tickets are required. Tickets will be available at the door, but if you get your tickets here at church, it can save you a lot of time at the event.

June 8-11, Pat Gates, Colleen Cook, and I will be attending the Great Plains Annual Conference in-person for the first time since 2019. The Annual Conference will take place in La Vista, Nebraska, a suburb of Omaha. Because I will be tied up in meetings the entire week, we will have a hymn sing on Sunday, June 12. Start thinking now about those favorite hymns you want to sing. The hymnals will be returned to the pews on that Sunday to make your selections easier.

Our final total for our Easter and Lenten offering was \$8765 to purchase mobility carts through Mobility Worldwide. That's enough for 25 carts! Thank you for your generosity! We will be receiving a cart for our church to decorate sometime this month. If you would like to help with the decorating, please talk to Colleen Cook. There will also be a celebration in Columbia on Sunday, July 17, 1-4 PM. Several of us are planning to attend this event. If enough people are interested in going, we may need to rent a bus or van to all ride together. Please let me know by June 12 if you would like to attend so that we can make appropriate transportation arrangements.

We have also ordered a children's cart from Mobility Worldwide to be decorated during a community-wide Vacation Bible School which will take place on Saturday, July 9 at the City Park on 38<sup>th</sup> Street. Jennifer Beard has agreed to take the lead in coordinating this event with several churches in KCK. Please let Jennifer know how you can help with VBS.

I hope you will be able to join with us as we move into the months of summer. Check out the calendar on page 3 for all the things that are going on at the church.

# SUNDAY SCHOOL Two Adult Sunday School Classes are available




