Summer has begun, and the busy-ness of July reflects that fact! It begins with my vacation July 1-10. Steve and I will be participating in a cross-country bicycle trip from Pittsburgh, PA to Cumberland MD. We've been training for weeks, but I have to admit, I'm a little concerned. Oddly enough, I'm not quite as young as I once was, and the heat and the miles take their toll. I'd appreciate your prayers for us for our travel and the ride itself. We begin a new sermon series in July that will carry through until Labor Day. What might we learn if we took the risk to listen? If we took the risk to let these holy ones of God become our traveling companions on our summer journey? We might be troubled, and we will be, but we might also be lifted up. We might be challenged, but we might find reasons for hope, or we might find a renewed vision that inspires us for all the journeys we make. So, what do you say? Are you up for a journey this summer, a journey to the edge of our faith? Then, you're ready for "Prophet Margins."

On July 3, we will have a guest preacher to kick off this series. The Rev. Emily Stirewalt is an ordained Elder in the Missouri Conference, where she serves as the Silver Link Pastor at the United Methodist Church of the Resurrection in Leawood. She and her husband Randall have two young children, all of whom I suspect will be attending worship with Emily. I hope you will be especially welcoming to this young family. Communion will be offered as usual on this first Sunday of the month. On July 10, we will deviate slightly from the series as our own Margo Sims Gardner brings a message based on the parable of the Good Samaritan which will challenge

listeners to examine their motives and what drives them.

We do have several exciting events coming up in July, as well. A community-wide Vacation Bible School will take place at City Park on July 9. Registration happens at 10:00 AM, and the learning, fun, and games will continue until 2:00 PM, followed by lunch. Please invite the children in your life to participate. July 17 following worship, several of us will travel to Columbia, MO to attend the Craft Beer & Carts festival for Mobility Worldwide. Tim Stowe, of our congregation, will be traveling to Africa in November to help with the assembly and distribution of the carts we helped to donate to this organization. We have designated the loud offerings collected in the past for a mission trip to be used to support Tim's travel, and we have resumed these loud offerings on the third Sunday of the month to continue to raise funds. Our June loud offering raised over \$600 towards this goal, and there will be other opportunities to contribute in the future.

One of those opportunities will be on Saturday, July 23, when we will have an Ice Cream Social at 5:00 PM. The social is free, but you are welcome to make a donation toward Tim's trip. This will precede game night so if you want to hang around and play games afterwards, I encourage you to do so.

Rounding out the month, we will receive any new members who express an interest in joining Wyandotte Church on the fifth Sunday, July 31. We will also have a fellowship dinner to welcome them and to share in a meal together.

I hope you will be able to join us for one, or many, of these opportunities to be together as the church.


The Crusaders Class is an adult Sunday school class that meets in the room just off Fellowship Hall. They participate in a number of different studies. This class also meets at 9:00 am.


Children's Sunday school available when children are present.


