
SUNDAY SCHOOL

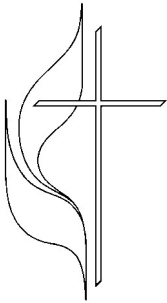
