As we head into the holidays, Advent has already begun on November 27. Our series "Advent Song of Ascents" continues through December 18, and then we are fully into the Christmas season (which technically does not begin until Christmas Day).

Our December schedule has slightly changed due to the way Christmas falls on the calendar this year. Christmas Eve is on a Saturday, and we will have our Christmas Eve Communion and Candlelighting Service at 6:00 PM. On Christmas morning, which falls on Sunday this year, we will worship at 10:00 AM as usual, but Sunday school will be shortened to allow people to spend more time with their families. On Christmas day ONLY, Sunday school will begin at 9:30 AM to allow classes to gather and connect before worship.

The poinsettias will grace our sanctuary beginning on December 18. If you would like to purchase one in memory or honor of a loved one, the cost is \$10. Order forms will be available on December 4, and need to be turned in by December 11. If you purchase a poinsettia, please plan to take it home with you following worship on the 25th or January 1st.

Because Christmas Eve falls on the Saturday when we would typically have Family Game Night, the Education Committee has planned a Family Christmas Games and Craft event for Saturday, December 17, 4-7 PM. Come for dinner and fun, or just to grab a bite. A variety of soups will be available (sign-up at worship). Of course, all ages are welcome to join our reindeer games, red noses or not! We will also have a New Year's Eve game night on Saturday, December 31, 6-9 PM.

As I mentioned last month, our Advent and Christmas giving focus is the work of the United Methodist Committee on Relief (UMCOR). The southeastern United States, and especially Florida, were hit hard this fall by storms and hurricanes. UMCOR uses all the money donated for disaster response and relief to directly respond to catastrophic events. Administrative funds are raised through an annual special offering in March. You can rest assured that all money donated to relief will be used for that purpose.

Finally, if you haven't turned in your pledge card yet, please do so at your earliest convenience.



The Crusaders Class is an adult Sunday school class that meets in the room just off Fellowship Hall. They participate in a number of different studies. This class also meets at 9:00 am.


Children's Sunday school is available when children are present.
