Happy New Year!

As we begin this New Year, I'm once again amazed by the generosity of our congregation. As of this writing the week before Christmas, with one Sunday remaining, we have already received \$4,255 toward our Advent and Christmas offerings for UMCOR. I shouldn't be so surprised. In the eight and a half years I've been here, the congregation of Wyandotte UMC has always stepped up whenever a need is expressed. I hope that never changes.

As we move into the New Year, we find ourselves once again in that place of thinking about the past and looking to the future. Are there changes we need to make, and will we be successful at following through? Our resolutions fade, but God's promises last forever. We get the message, "New Year, new you," from pop culture, year after year. We vow to make changes to our diet, exercise habits, or lifestyle, but in spite of those resolutions, most things stay the same. This may be cause for disappointment, but there is some consistency we can celebrate. Our new sermon series to carry us through Epiphany is called "New Year, Same Promises," as we look at the ongoing promises of God. God's promises to us do not change with the calendar or the latest fitness trend. Rather than focusing our energy and attention on making (and in all likelihood breaking) promises to ourselves, let's spend the first part of the new year appreciating God's unbreakable promises.

With five Sundays in the month of January, we will once again have a fifth Sunday fellowship dinner following worship. This will be a potluck, and we will have a special program presented by Tim Stowe as he shares with us his experiences from his trip to Kenya helping with the distribution of the mobility carts we participated in purchasing. I hope everyone will be able to join us to hear his stories form the trip.

Finally, with the season of inclement weather upon us, I wanted to make you aware of our closing policies and practices. Often, when we receive snow and/or ice, the streets around the church become impassible, and this presents a serious danger to anyone attempting to drive or walk on them. As primarily residential streets, they are often the last to be treated or plowed. Whenever I find on Sunday morning that we have had a snow or ice event, I contact our trustees, and together we make the decision whether or not to close. If the decision is made to close, the closing will be posted on the church's Facebook page, and a One Call will be sent out. Furthermore, I will attempt to get the information on as many local TV stations as possible, but despite repeated attempts, some have been more difficult to get set up. I have been able to consistently get closings on KCTV(5), KMBC (9 & 29) and KSHB (41 & 38). To date, I have not been able to post on WDAF (Fox 4). During the week, conference policy recommends that if the schools are closed in an area, the churches should be as well. Your safety is primary to us. 


The Crusaders Class is an adult Sunday school class that meets in the room just off Fellowship Hall. They participate in a number of different studies. This class also meets at 9:00 am.


