Heading into February, we are torn between thinking winter may never end and being hopeful for spring and the experience of resurrection. What better time for Lent to begin.

During the month of February we will be finishing up our current sermon series "New Year, Same Promises" as we look at the ongoing promises of God. Following that we will head off into our Lenten series "The God Story" which uses the traditional elements of storytelling to help us see the threads that run through the Bible from Genesis to Revelation.

Lent is intended to be a time of self-denial, moderation, fasting, and the forsaking of sinful activities and habits. Ash Wednesday commences this period of spiritual discipline. This year, Ash Wednesday falls on February 22. I will be available at the church that day, 8-9 AM, 12-1 PM, and 4:30-5:30 PM for anyone who wishes to stop by to receive the cross of ashes on their forehead as a reminder of our relationship with Christ. As we hear the words, "Remember you are dust and to dust you shall return," we are reminded of our own mortality, and of the crucifixion of Christ, and we are called to repentance from our sins.

Also in conjunction with the Lenten season, we will once again offer a Lenten Bible study to go with the sermon series. This will take place on Wednesday evenings during Lent, beginning on Ash Wednesday at 6:00 PM. During the month of February, these will take place at the church, and dinner will be provided. I hope you will be able to join us for this study.

Last, but certainly not least, the Outreach committee has Identified UMCOR as the recipient of our Lenten and Easter special offering. We had a wonderful response to our Advent and Christmas offering, yet there seems to be no end to the needs for UMCOR response. I want to challenge our church to not only meet, but to exceed, the amount we raised in December for this vital ministry of the Methodist Church.

Have a great month, and I'll see you in church (and the grocery store, and the library, and ...?)




The Crusaders Class is an adult Sunday school class that meets in the room just off Fellowship Hall. They participate in a number of different studies. This class also meets at 9:00 am.


