Spring is almost here! And with the new season comes all the activity that comes with spring.

Lent began on February 22 with the observation of Ash Wednesday. We have already begun our Lenten sermon series *The God Story* and the accompanying Bible study. We meet each Wednesday at 6:00 PM, either at the church or one of our regular Dinner Out restaurants to share a meal and consider the Bible from what may be a new perspective for many.

Along with Lent and Easter comes another opportunity for our church to demonstrate our generosity. The Outreach Committee has once again identified UMCOR (United Methodist Committee on Relief) as the recipient of this special offering. The recent earthquakes in Turkey and Syria have devastated many lives and UMCOR is already responding. Our new bishop, David Wilson has also requested the churches of the Great Plains Conference contribute to UMCOR's response. Throughout Lent, you may mark your special offerings UMCOR, Lent, or Easter. Every cent contributed goes directly to disaster response.

The only exception to this is on March 19, when we observe UMCOR Sunday. On this Sunday only, special offerings marked for UMCOR will go to support the administrative costs of the organization. This is the only time throughout the year that UMCOR receives support for administrative cost. I hope you will choose to give generously to support both the administrative and relief efforts of UMCOR.

We will once again begin our neighborhood walks on March 28. We will meet each Tuesday and Thursday in the west parking lot at 8:00 AM and walk around the neighborhood for a half and hour to an hour. Join us to get a little exercise and maybe meet some of our neighbors.

Finally, even though it's not happening until April, because the Easter Egg Hunt has been scheduled for April 1, it's important that you know about it in March. The hunt will take place from 2 to 3 in the afternoon. We will fill eggs at 10 AM and hide them beginning about 12:30 PM. Please invite children in your life and neighborhoods to join us for this fun event. Candy can be brought to the church throughout the month of March.



The Crusaders Class is an adult Sunday school class that meets in the room just off Fellowship Hall. They participate in a number of different studies. This class also meets at 9:00 am.


Children's Sunday school is available when children are present.


