You won't be seeing much of me during the month of May. Steve and I will once again be traveling to Italy to see parts of the country we missed on our trip in 2019. I will only be available the first week in May, and then will be out until the week after Memorial Day. During my absence, I have asked a friend of mine to fill in for both preaching and pastoral care. His name is Loren Drummond and we attended seminary together. I felt it was unfair to add these extra burdens to Loren's workload as he brings you the word on Sundays. That means if you want to hear new content, you need to come to church!




The Crusaders Class is an adult Sunday school class that meets in the room just off Fellowship Hall. They participate in a number of different studies. This class also meets at 9:00 am.




