Ruth Miller coordinates the volunteers for the Food Kitchen and offers our Mission Moment each month. She said that she doesn't have to be the only one who does that, so if anyone else is interested, let me know. Robert Chadwick is one of our newer members and in addition to working at the Food Kitchen, he offers a new perspective on the things we do. Last, but certainly not least, Tim Stowe gathers those things collected for the HUB and delivers them to Argentine on a monthly basis. He also represented our church on a Mobility Cart delivery trip to Africa last November, and I think he is making plans to go back this year! A big thank you to these individuals that work hard at helping our community know that we love them.

Our Annual Charge Conference has been scheduled by the KC District for Sunday, November 12, 1-3 PM at Grace United Methodist Church in Olathe. Because we need to approve all the forms to be submitted prior to that meeting, we are moving our regularly scheduled September Administrative Council meeting to October 15 to allow adequate time to prepare the items without scheduling an additional meeting before the Charge Conference. Please put both of these important meetings on your calendars so you can plan to attend.



The Crusaders Class is an adult Sunday school class that meets in the room just off Fellowship Hall. They participate in a number of different studies. This class also meets at 9:00 am.


Children's Sunday school is available when children are present.

CLOTHING CLOSET






