
SUNDAY SCHOOL Two Adult Sunday School Classes are available

bookstore. Grab a copy for yourself and come join us! The Wired Word will continue to be sent out, but we probably won't pick it back up until the fall.


The Crusaders Class is an adult Sunday school class that meets in the room just off Fellowship Hall. They participate in a number of different studies. This class also meets at 9:00 am.




