Tuesday-Friday 9:00AM—12:00PM (but please call first!) Office closed on Monday Wow! I can't believe that it's already December. It seems that once we hit October, the days just fly by! And as usual, we have a lot going on at Wyandotte United Methodist Church.

Advent begins on Sunday, December 3, so our annual decorating party will take place on December 2, beginning about 10:00 AM. We're hopeful that we will have a lot of people to help out because many hands make light work.

This year, our Advent series is based on the book *Stay Awhile: Advent Lessons in Divine Hospitality* by Kara Eidson, one of my clergy colleagues who serves the McClouth and Oskaloosa First United Methodist Churches. This book explores Advent through the lens of hospitality from a midwestern perspective, and I'm looking forward to diving into it.

Advent starts as late as it possibly can this year. The first Sunday of Advent is December 3, which makes Sunday, December 24 the fourth Sunday of Advent. Because that is also Christmas Eve, we will have two services on Christmas Eve: the fourth Sunday of Advent in the morning at 10:00 AM, and our traditional Christmas Eve Communion and Candlelighting service at 6:00 PM.

This year, for our Advent and Christmas offering, we have chosen Mobility Worldwide to once again receive our special offerings. During Lent of 2021, we set a goal of ten carts at \$350 each, but raised enough for twenty-five. The cost per cart has gone up to \$425 each, and Advent is shorter than Lent, so the Outreach committee has set a goal of twelve carts. I have no doubt that our exceedingly generous congregation will be able to meet, and exceed, that goal. On December 3, Gary Moreau with Mobility Worldwide will join us in the sanctuary during the Sunday School hour (9:00 AM) to tell us more about giving the Gift of Mobility. All are welcome!

It is common in our church to brighten our sanctuary during the Advent season with poinsettias that have been donated in memory or honor of individuals. In the past, the church has purchased live flowers that the contributors are invited to take home with them after the Christmas Eve service. Often, these live flowers are left behind, and frequently end up being thrown away as they do not receive adequate care in the days following Christmas. This year, the Worship committee has decided to purchase artificial poinsettias instead of live ones. People can still donate toward their purchase in honor or memory of a loved one, and they are still welcome to take one home, but any left over after Christmas can be stored and reused in future years. Anyone still wishing to purchase a live poinsettia may do so on your own and share it with the congregation during the Advent season if you wish, but we still ask that you take it home with you after Christmas.

Finally, although December has a fifth Sunday, because it falls on December 31, we have decided to not have a fifth Sunday potluck this month. Instead, our monthly game night will take place that evening from 6-9 PM as an alternative to New Year's Eve revelry. As usual, everyone of all ages is welcome.

I hope you will be able to join us for one, if not all, of these December activities. Have a great Advent, and I'll see you in church.




The Crusaders Class is an adult Sunday school class that meets in the room just off Fellowship Hall. They participate in a number of different studies. This class also meets at 9:00 am.




