As I write this near the end of February, we are experiencing close to the warmest February on record. This, after experiencing (what felt like) the coldest January. Daylight Savings time begins March 10 (remember to SPRING FORWARD) and it feels more and more like Spring every day!

Our Lenten Bible study continues through March 27. Each Wednesday throughout Lent we have been gathering in Fellowship Hall for a meal and a study of "Witness at the Cross" by Amy-Jill Levine. The participants in the study continue to be challenged and enlightened by the study as we consider those people who were present at Jesus' crucifixion and how their lives were influenced and affected by the times in which they lived and their encounters and relationships with Jesus of Nazareth. And we've had some really good food, too! You can still join us for the remaining sessions on throughout the month of March. We will gather at 6 PM to eat, and the study will begin around 6:30, after everyone has had a chance to eat and visit a bit. We're usually done by about 7:30 or 8:00 PM, depending on how quickly we get started.

On Saturday, March 23, we will have our Easter egg hunt at the church. We will gather in the morning at 10:00 to fill the eggs, 12:30 PM to hide them, and then the hunt will take place in the afternoon at 2:00 PM. As in years past, the hunt will be divided into designated zones for the different age groups to give each group the opportunity to grab all the eggs they can. We will need assistance filling and hiding the eggs, and general oversight during the hunt itself. I hope you can join us!

We will have a Maundy Thursday service at 7:00 PM on Thursday, March 28. This is a communion service at which we recall the Last Supper that Jesus observed with his disciples.

On Easter Sunday, March 31, we will have an early service beginning at 7:30. It's not quite sunrise, but it is an observance of SON-Rise. This will be followed by breakfast in Fellowship Hall beginning about 8:00 and continuing until 9:00. Sunday school will take place as usual at 9, and we will celebrate the resurrection of our Savior with communion at our regular service at 10:00 AM. Breakfast will once again be prepared by Steve and friends, but we could probably use a couple of breakfast casseroles to supplement. Let me know if you can provide one.

Our sermon series through the Lenten season will continue as we consider "Depths of Love." In this series, we are invited to lay our lives alongside the life of Jesus. What we discover in this examination of his life and ours, is not condemnation or recrimination. Instead, the farther we go on this journey with him, we are overwhelmed by the depths of love he has for all of us. Lent is a time for getting our spiritual house in order, but above all, it is an invitation to once again commit to love like Christ loves.

Finally, our Lenten giving focus this year is the work of the United Methodist Committee on Relief (UMCOR). Often, during a natural disaster, UMCOR is the first to arrive in response and the last to leave. And the amazing thing that separates UMCOR from other response organizations is that every dollar donated toward their work actually goes to the actual response in areas of greatest need. All administrative costs are generated during one Sunday a year in United Methodist churches around the globe. It is called UMCOR Sunday and this year it falls on March 10. Donations for UMCOR received on March 10 will go directly to this special offering. But every other Sunday in March, donations designated for UMCOR will go directly to disaster response. Be sure to mark your contributions UMCOR, Lent, or Easter to support this important work.

March is going to be another busy month, but through it all, let's continue to seek ways of bringing new people to Jesus through our love of our neighbors. Feel free to invite others to any and all of our regular and special activities, and keep looking for places where we can reach new people with the love of Christ.

The Crusaders Class is an adult Sunday school class that meets in the room just off Fellowship Hall. They participate in a number of different studies. This class also meets at 9:00 am.


Children's Sunday school is available when children are present.




