Summer is upon us! That means travel and sports and meetings and gardening and who knows what else! I know my schedule involves these kinds of things. I hope yours does, too, but that in the midst of it all that you continue to find time to spend with God in service and in worship.

Annual Conference is rapidly approaching. We will meet in Kearney, NE June 6-9. The theme of Conference this year is "Ready for the Journey." I'm not sure if that has anything to do with the five hours it takes to get there, but our Lay Delegate Pat Gates will be my traveling companion. Among the things I'm sure we will be discussing at Annual Conference are the various pieces of legislation that passed at General Conference in late April and early May. Among these items are a plan for regionalization, allowing Europe, Africa, the Philippines, and the United States to legislate in a manner more consistent with cultural differences; the full inclusion of LGBTQ persons in ministry, including ordination and marriage; and granting permission for Ordained Deacons to administer the Sacraments within their ministry settings.

On a more local level, a proposal for redistricting within the Great Plains Annual Conference has been submitted for approval. Since the Kansas East, Kansas West, and Nebraska Conferences united in 2014 into the Great Plains Conference, there have been seventeen districts, each with a District Superintendent and Administrator. Due to a number of disaffiliations and shrinking numbers, the decision had been made to reduce the number of districts to ten, with the current Kansas City District becoming the Northeast Kansas District, with boundaries extending to Lawrence on the west, the state line to the north, and Osawatomie on the south. I will post a full copy of the report on the bulletin board in Fellowship Hall so you can see it for yourself.

At the end of June we will celebrate summer and the completion of my tenth full year at Wyandotte UMC with a fifth Sunday potluck on June 30 following worship. Let's turn that into a bring-a-friend Sunday, so that we can welcome more people to help us eat all that food! The appointments will be officially set at Annual Conference, but as far as I know at this point, I will be returning for year 11 at Wyandotte UMC!

We have partnered with Claude Huyck Elementary school for many years, and in the past we have held school supply drives for them. We haven't done that in several years because the district was providing them, but once again, they have asked for our help. On page 4 of this newsletter, you will find a list of the school supplies they have requested. You might carry this list with you and as you visit various stores, if you see a good deal on something on the list, you might want to pick up a few items to help out. If you need an additional copy of the list, extras will be available on the worship sign-in table.




