In the United Methodist Church, July 1 represents the beginning of a new appointment year. I'm pleased to announce that I have been reappointed to Wyandotte Church to serve another year. We celebrated my ten-year anniversary with a potluck dinner on June 30, and as I begin my second decade here, I am extremely grateful for the many wonderful people in this congregation, and I look forward to (hopefully) many more years of working in ministry together with you.

The season from Pentecost to the first Sunday of Advent is referred to as "ordinary" time. In the early church the time following Pentecost was a period of rapid church growth, with thousands of persons hearing of the saving love of Jesus Christ and choosing to place their trust in God's grace. The people were filled with the Holy Spirit and inspired with amazing gifts to be put to use in spreading the Good News of Christ. I'd call that far from "ordinary"!

Some people think times have changed, that we don't have these same gifts today. I think they have been misled. I hope you will make every effort to join us in this journey through the writings to the church at Ephesus.

I will be traveling to Colorado Springs for continuing education and will be gone July 15-21. Please pray for traveling mercies for all the participants. Children's Sunday school is available when children are present.






