As we move into November, our current sermon series on the Fruit of the Spirit, as listed in Galatians 5:22-23, continues. On November 3 we will observe All Saints Sunday with a discussion of Faithfulness and a remembrance of those whom we have lost since this time last year. During Holy Communion, you will be given the opportunity to light candles of remembrance for your loved ones. 




