Advent is here, and with it, the new church year. The Season of Advent is one of the highlights of the Christian Year. With this season, we launch another cycle of living into the story of Jesus and the church that emerges—of which we are a part. I sometimes think we need to find a new way of telling this story and do something fresh and unique. There is certainly space for that, but tradition and remembering the songs and stories from our beginnings can be a powerful invitation to grow as disciples as we grow closer to Christ. So, I want to invite you to consider the Preparations and the Passion of Advent so that we might embrace the Presence and Promise of the Christ who comes. And through it all, we will gather to worship. So, come, let us adore him.

At the time of this writing, we are still working on bringing some special music into our worship during the month of December. Nothing is yet confirmed, but we wouldn't want anyone to miss any special performances by people from our community.

During the month of December, our Advent and Christmas offering for UMCOR continues. At the beginning of November, we were already able to send \$2,360 to UMCOR to support their relief efforts within the US, especially from the hurricanes earlier this year. When natural disasters strike, UMCOR is often one of the first of the many aid groups to arrive on the scene AND one of the last to leave. I hope you will be able to help support these efforts through your contributions. You can make your donation to the church and mark it UMCOR in the memo, or you can give directly to UMCOR in one of the following ways. You can designate Wyandotte UMC there so the church gets credit, just be sure to select the one in Kansas! Other opportunities for holiday giving include our regular collections for the HUB, the Hat & Mitten Tree (gloves and scarves also welcome), and the Salvation Army angels. Also, don't forget to get your orders to Donna Lesher for gift cards, beyond what she usually stocks, by December 8 to make sure you get them before Christmas.

Our Christmas Eve Candlelight and Communion service will take place on December 24 at 6:00 PM. Please invite your friends and family to join us for this always very meaningful service when we hear the stories of Christmas through scripture and song.

With December having five Sundays, we will have a fifth Sunday Fellowship Dinner following worship on the December 29. Join us if you can, and if you have additional family in town, bring them along. It's always fun to see family members we've heard about and to be able to put faces to names.

As we move into the New Year, we would like to be able to close out the books by December 31. Please make sure your offerings for 2024 are received by the church on or before the last Sunday, December 29.

Finally (I think!), our monthly game night for this month will be moved from the fourth Saturday to New Year's Eve, December 31. It will begin around 5 PM as usual, with no predetermined cut-off time. It's doubtful that it will go to midnight, but you just never know!

I hope everyone has a wonderful Advent and Christmas season, and that our church will continue to spread love and light to all we encounter. Blessings,






