Tuesday-Friday 9:00AM—12:00PM (but please call first!) Office closed on Monday The Season of Lent is often seen as a somber and even silent season. Certainly, there is space for contemplation, for embracing the quiet, for being still to seek out God. Many of us, however, find music a helpful tool for contemplation. So, in the series from Ash Wednesday through Easter Sunday, "Steadfast Love: A Lenten Playlist," we will consider the music of our lives and how it helps us in making connections, plumbing the depths of the heart and soul of the community of faith and the wider culture.

Ash Wednesday commences this period of spiritual discipline. This year, Ash Wednesday falls on March 5. I will be available at the church that day, 9-10 AM, 12-1 PM, and 4:00-5:00 PM for anyone who wishes to stop by to receive the cross of ashes on their forehead as a reminder of our relationship with Christ. As we hear the words, "Remember you are dust and to dust you shall return," we are reminded of our own mortality, and of the crucifixion of Christ, and we are called to repentance from our sins.

And then, beginning that same evening, in conjunction with the Lenten season, we will once again offer a Lenten Bible study. I have chosen the book *Jesus' Vision for You One Wild and Precious Life* by Mike Graves for our study. In this book, rather than focusing on the seven last words of a dying Jesus, author Mike Graves draws the reader's attention to the seven first words – or, as he calls them – the seven essential sayings. With each of the seven words/teachings of Jesus, Graves leads us in an exploration of the Gospels and also provides some social commentary on our day, In doing so, Graves reflects on how these sayings by Jesus can help shape our wild and precious lives today. Our study will take place on Wednesday evenings during Lent, beginning on Ash Wednesday at 6:00 PM. These will take place at the church, and dinner will be provided. I hope you will be able to join us for this study. There will be NO Wyandotte Dinners Out during Lent. A sign-up sheet for volunteers to provide the dinners will be available at the first study session. The books and the study schedule are now available in the office, if you want to get a jump-start on your reading.

The Outreach committee has identified Heifer International as the recipient of our Lenten and Easter special offering. Heifer International's mission is to end hunger and poverty while caring for the Earth. By gifting livestock, training, tools and resources to families in need, they instill hope, a source of income, and a brighter tomorrow. Heifer helps small farmers earn more income, while also generating economic opportunity for rural women, youth, and Indigenous populations. You'll hear more about Heifer International in the upcoming weeks, but I hope you will consider giving to this worthwhile ministry.

Can you believe that Fonda Telthorst has been our Music Director for ten years now?! We will celebrate her tenth anniversary with us on Sunday, March 30 with our Fifth Sunday Potluck Fellowship Dinner. Please plan to join us to help let Fonda know all that her music ministry means to us.

Finally, we have been approached by the Resurrection Life Family Worship Center with a request to release the mortgage owed to us on the former Grandview UMC building in exchange for a cash offer. We will have a Church/Charge Conference to consider and vote on this matter on Sunday, April 13 following worship. Please mark this date on your calendar and plan to attend so that your voice can be heard.



Donations can be placed in the Fellowship Hall.






#### **HUB Information**
