March was a whirlwind, both literally and figuratively, and now April has arrived with even more on our schedule!

Our Lenten book study is going well with over twenty people participating. We are studying the book *Jesus' Vision for Your One Wild and Precious Life* by Dr. Mike Graves, and are discovering things many of us never considered about the Bible and Jesus' life and focus. The study continues through April 16, meeting on Wednesdays at 6:00 PM with dinner provided. It's not too late to join in. The book is available on Amazon.

As I mentioned in the March newsletter, we will have an all-church conference on Sunday, April 13, following worship. This meeting has been called to address an offer we have received from Resurrection Family Worship Center to "pay-off" the mortgage that is owed to us at a level below the remaining principal balance. Normally, the initial response to this would be "no," but in consideration of other contributing factors, the Trustees and Administrative Council felt it was best to bring it to the full congregation. Again, this will take place following worship on April 13. The District Superintendent will be here to conduct the conference and all are invited to attend.

As we head into Easter, there are several related activities you'll want to be a part of. Our annual Easter egg hunt will also take place on Sunday, April 13 at 3:30 PM. Leading up to that, however, are the filling and hiding of the eggs. We will fill the eggs on Saturday, April 12, beginning at 1:00 PM, and will hide them on Sunday, April 13 at 1:00 PM. Many hands make light work, and your help with these activities is very much appreciated. We will continue to receive candy up until the time for filling the eggs.

We will observe a Maundy Thursday service on Thursday, April 17 at 6:00 PM, as we once again consider Jesus' institution of Holy Communion at the Last Supper. All are welcome.

On Sunday, April 20, we will celebrate Easter and Jesus' resurrection with a "SonRise" service at 7:30 AM. This will be followed by breakfast at 8:00, Sunday school at 9:00, and joyful, celebratory worship and Communion at 10:00 AM. This is the reason that the Church exists and it is important that we gather and praise God for all the gifts we receive, especially the grace embodied in Jesus' resurrection. Won't you join us, and bring a friend?

Our special offerings for Heifer International continue through Easter, although gifts will be received through the end of April. Please support in whatever way you can to help bring hope and healing through the gifts of water, seed, farm animals, and training provided by Heifer International throughout our world. If you have already contributed, thank you!

I will be on vacation or generally unavailable most of the week of April 21, and will return for worship on April 27. We will have a hymn sing that Sunday with songs from the United Methodist Hymnal and The Faith We Sing. Pastoral care during my absence will be available from Rev. 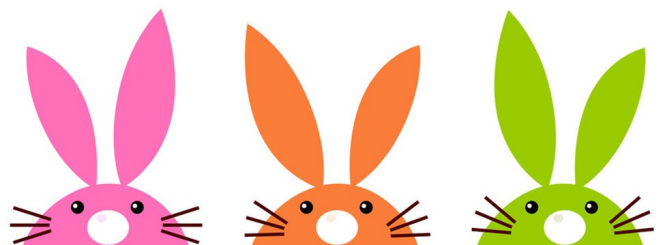
#### **Help Raise Funds for Church Maintenance Projects**
