Friends,

Let me begin by providing an update on the Resurrection Life Family Worship Center mortgage. We met in a Charge Conference on April 13, and voted 16-3-1 (yes, no, abstention) to release the mortgage on the former Grandview UMC building in exchange for \$100,000 cash. The District Superintendent will take this to the District Connecting Council (formerly Church Building and Location) and will also ask the Conference Chancellor to review the documents provided by Resurrection Life for the release of the mortgage. Following these steps and any necessary revisions, the closing will be finalized.

The Season of Easter continues during May, and throughout this season, we explore themes from Revelation and the Gospel of John about what is possible when we believe. In this series we can learn more about the power of our belief in Christ, and how belief is not only an intellectual endeavor and assent to the power of God to transform, but also a process that helps us use our hands and feet in ways similar to how Jesus used his hands and feet to seek out and address the hurting ones, including our planet and its most vulnerable people and other creatures. I hope you will join us for this worship in this season.

March and April were extremely busy, but May should be much calmer. As a little change of pace, I want to share with you the lovely "Thank you" note we received from Fonda:
